

And Toby's head is screwed on - literally! After a major crash in earlier years, his neck has a steel-strap attached to the top of his spine! Go Toby!!



Evans Head Fly in - January 9:



Book of the month: Harley Davidson - A Way of Life


by Albert Saladini and Pascal Szymezak
