7th Aussie Triples Rally

This year's Triples Rally ran from the 19th – 21st August and was again based at the beautiful seaside town of Evans Head, Northern NSW.

We had 52 entrants bring their Triumph Tridents and BSA Rocket 3's for three days of riding in perfect weather. Entrants came from as far as South Australia, Victoria, the ACT and Queensland. Many rode large distances to the Rally while others trailered their bikes. Fridays short ride was south to Iluka Pub for a meal and a chat, as most riders only come together once a year at this Rally. We were joined on the ride by some members of the NRCMCC and met at Iluka by members of the Clarence Valley Club.

Saturday the local soccer club, the "Woodburn Wolves", provided a great breakfast for us before we headed off for a 220km ride with a fuel and wee stop at Mullumbimby before the journey to Alstonville Public School for lunch and the bike judging. We had a variety of Triples including T150's T160's, Rocket 3's, Hurricanes, a Legend, a Son of Sam replica and a stunning Rob North Rocket 3. After lunch we headed back to Evans Head where some of our visitors crawled over the F1-11 at the Air Museum.

The presentation Dinner was held at the Evans Head Bowlo and included our annual charity auction of anything Triple. The Trident and Rocket 3 Owners Club in England sent Club Merchandise out for the event. Jeff from Re-engineered Concentrics donated several bottles of Hunter Valley Port with our Logo etched into the bottle. We were also supported by the local Chamber of Commerce. All profits go to the local Cancer Care Unit.



Triples rally continued:

Sunday saw a few sore heads and excellent weather as we lined the Triples and the Marshalls' bikes up in the Main St of Evans Head for a public display for 2 hours. This created a lot of interest with people travelling a long way to see them. Following this display we had a two hour ride returning to North Coast Holiday Park, Evans Head for a BBQ lunch, supplied by the park management, as a farewell to entrants and a thank you to the Marshalls from Northern Rivers Classic Motorcycle Club who once again did an amazing job of guiding us through our hinterland roads.

The preparation and presentation of these bikes is commendable, with the only breakdown at the Rally being a punctured rear wheel.

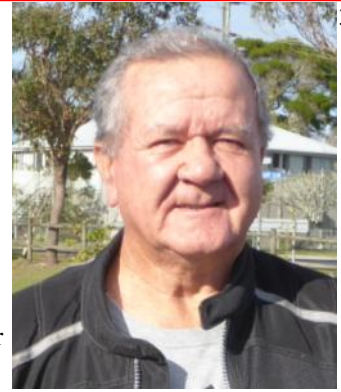

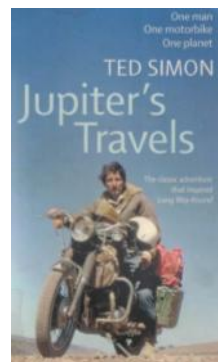

## My recent working trip overseas - by Dean Marsh; part 1 (part 2 in October newsletter)

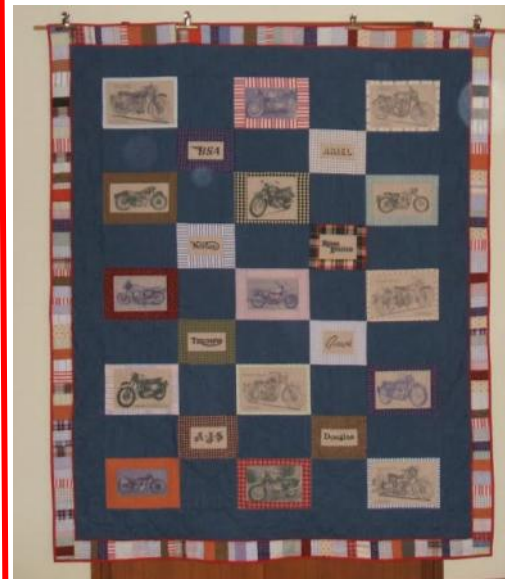
I remember as if it were yesterday Dad (Alec Marsh) sitting up late at night writing articles to go into the NRMCC newsletter. Time to carry on Dad's legacy and contribute to the club that enabled Dad to enjoy his love for classic motorcycles while being in the company of his old bikie mates.

I can never go overseas on a work trip without throwing in some pleasure activities which of course always involves 2 wheels. Whether its on a mountain biking adventure, a race meeting or even just a m/cycle museum the last trip I went on involved all 3. Back in April I attended a "Study Tour", Study Tour being the word used by Tractor salesman to tell our wives about work trips that usually involves drinking a lot of beer with like - minded tractor salesman on the other side of the world. This study tour was to ALO's manufacturing facilities in Ningbo China and Umeo Sweden. Like most successful AG based companies today ALO was started by the need for one man in the early 1900's to make manual farm chores easier, Karl Astrom invented the very first tractor front end loader and today ALO is the largest front-end loader manufacturer in the world making 35,000 loaders per year.

After travelling through regional China where your motorcycle wears the gloves (see pic 1) it was a very nice sight to land in Sweden and be greeted with an array of Nilfisk motorised wheel chairs (See pic 2). In 1918 Nilfisk made the very first Nimbus motorcycle - The Stovepipe. The ALO Head office was in a small town Umeo, a 2 hour flight North from Stockholm. Ironically almost the whole town worked for ALO and in one way or another most of the factory staff we spoke to were related to the founder!! How would you like to pay 75% of your wage in taxes but have free medical, pay no school or university fees, no rates and cheap car rego? I suppose that's why Sweden a county less than half the size of Australia can lay claim to fame for such brands as IKEA, Electrolux, Ericsson, Skype, VOLVO, ALO, ABBA, Absolut Vodka and the most successful speedway rider of his time Tony Rickardsson.

After the work part was done in Umeo it was time for a 2 day Snow Mobiling expedition landing us in our own Ski Resort for the afternoon. As it turns out the tour guide owned the ski mountain, the season was over for the year and he basically said to the group the mountain is yours.
