<Marc Jennison commented that the club has been without a Treasurer for a couple of months now, noting that only the President & Secretary were able to initiate and pay club accounts. He moved a motion that the club appoint a new Treasurer for the remainder of this year and nominated Neil Williams, the motion was 2ND by Doug Hampson. Neil accepted the nomination, with the attending members voting unanimously to accept Neil as club Treasurer.




