**April Ride** - more details to come , will be decided at March Club meeting and published in April Newsletter also you'll receive an email from Secretary ASAP.

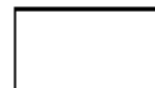

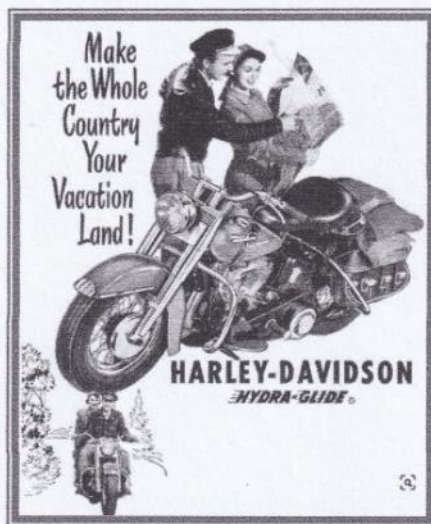

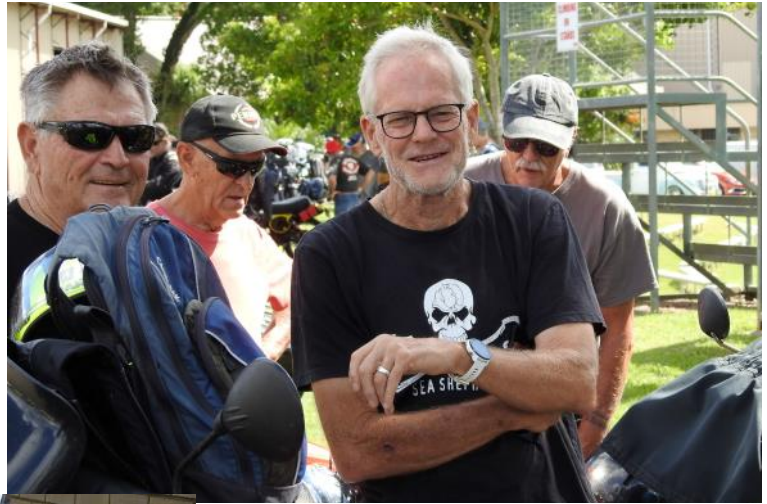
