- < GF noted the club is still without a President, + Ride Organisers for Sunday & Wednesday rides
- *Members were asked if anyone was prepared to take on the Presidents position, It was pointed out that we need a President for many reasons.. one being to fulfil Bank Requirements where 3 signatories are required. General discussion followed ..there were no takers for the Presidents position. To be revisited again at March meeting.
- *Wednesdays , first Sunday & Sunday club ride following club Meeting there was General

Discussion on all rides, rider numbers were down to 2 or 3 minimum, sometimes maybe 5 or 6 Max. people in general were not interested preferring to use their log books. Start times were discussed and further discussions will be held about earlier start time in summer. Further discussions followed about cancelling the 1st Sunday classic ride and the 2 Wednesday rides and concentrate on the one monthly Sunday club ride (after meeting) The members were asked for ideas. Current ride ideas were...

May Ride to meet up with the Arial Rally **A Motion** was moved by PL to cancel the club organised 1st Sunday Classic Ride 2nd MW - motion voted on and carried, Members are still free to organise and ride themselves but must use their log books.

A Motion was moved by Doug Foskey to cancel the clubs organised 1st &4th Wednesday rides of month 2nd by Will McMillan - motion voted on and carried, Members are still free to organise and ride themselves on these days, or any other days, but must use their log books

< MW on possible Show and Shine event locations for 2025, Autobarn carpark or possibly at Lenox Head, using Camping Ground area. Yet to be confirmed, MW also mentioned the 2025 club Rally, is still at Evans Head, but possibly for 2026 the Rally could be based at Lennox Head, using the Camping ground as a base.
